H1N1 Flu / “Swine Flu”***

The recent outbreak of “Swine Flu” has created a heightened awareness and need for decontamination services of facilities that have been impacted by this public health issue. PSC Environmental Services, through its Emergency Response Group, has the capability to respond immediately to provide decontamination services in accordance with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines.

PSC has extensive experience with similar public health emergencies that provide the expertise to respond to the Swine Flu outbreak. Past response actions have been performed for:

- Anthrax Decontamination - Anthrax is an acute infectious disease caused by the spore-forming bacterium *Bacillus anthracis*. During the anthrax scares in Washington DC and New York, PSC mobilized responders, performed field testing to identify if anthrax was present, and provided decontamination services as needed based on the results.
- Norovirus Decontamination - Noroviruses are a group of viruses that cause the “stomach flu,” or gastroenteritis, in people. PSC has responded to several cases of suspected Norovirus contamination and using a specialized cleaning agent decontaminated the sites returning them to a non-contagious condition.
- Bloodborne Pathogen Decontamination - Pathogens are a biological agent that causes disease or illness to its host, usually passed in humans through any bodily fluids. PSC has responded to thousands of blood or Other Potential Infection Material (OPIM) related incidents. Using universal precautions and specialized cleaning agents we have successfully decontaminated the impacted areas and provide safe secure disposal of any biological waste generated.

IF YOUR FACILITY IS DIRECTLY IMPACTED BY SWINE FLU NOW:

1. Call PSC at 1.877.577.2269 to initiate a response.
2. The response manager will take your call, begin the client set-up documentation, and send necessary documents and agreements for approval.
3. Once received, a response team will be dispatched immediately with all labor, cleaning agents, and equipment to fully decontaminate your office, classrooms, and other impacted spaces.
